Each pie or dessert maker will be asked to make their apple pie or apple dessert in advance and deliver the final product to the festival for judging on Saturday, September 11th. **Entries must be submitted to the Apple Pie & Dessert Contest Tent located by the Main Stage by 11:00am in Rochester Park. Judging will begin promptly at 11:30am and winners announced at approximately 12:30pm on the Main Stage.** Applicants must make either an apple pie or apple dessert using apples as the main ingredient. Celebrity judges will be on-site to sample your pie or dessert and award first, second, and third place in each category.

What Will I Win?

The first place winners of each category will have their recipe and story featured on the official Art & Apples Festival website and in the 2011 Festival Event Guide. First, second and third place winners in each category will receive a one-of-a-kind dessert/pie dish created by an exhibiting artist.
